


## Permitted area for combustible building structure



- If the stove is placed on a floor protector hearth plate made of glass for example (accessory option), the height from the floor will be increased by the thickness of the hearth plate; for a freestanding glass hearth plate this will be 10 mm.

  To prevent discolouration of painted non-combustible walls, we recommend the same safety spacing as for a combustible wall.
